

Its initial recording, Dong Folk Songs: People and Nature in Harmony, was honored in China's 2003 Ministry of Culture Media Awards and has been broadcast both in Europe and North America. More recently, the Workshop has garnered Travel & Leisure magazine's 2008 Global Vision Award for Cultural Preservation and was a featured subject in the May 2008 issue of National Geographic magazine.

In opera, his libretti include Philip Glass' THE VOYAGE (Metropolitan Opera), Osvaldo Golijov's AINADAMAR (two 2007 Grammy Awards), Unsuk Chin's ALICE IN WONDERLAND (Opernwelt 2007 "World Premiere of the Year"), and Howard Shore's THE FLY. Hwang also penned the feature films "M. Butterfly," "Golden Gate," and "Possession" (coauthor). He serves on the Council of the Dramatists Guild and was appointed by President Clinton to the President's Committee on the Arts and the Humanities.

**Telly Leung** (Director) (he/him) is a Chinese-American performer, producer, recording artist, and theater arts teacher from New York City.
